Dishes / Cutlery









I have the normal plastic camping equipment (dishes and cups) and the normal camping pans and cutlery that do a good job for my needs. Whether red, blue, white or gray does not matter. For the keeping of plates and pans I constructed a flexible system in my kitchen that can easily be amended if necessary. The single compartments of my cupboard consist of 2mm aluminum L-profiles that are strung together. To reduce clanging during driving, I have laid a simple kitchen mat at the bottom and fixed some foam material at the back of the cases. Also included in my cupboard is a compartment for spices, soap, mugs, cups and other small items.

The upwardly swinging door can be used as a small table when unfolded. I have protected the door against opening with two simple lockings.

As basically all parts are constructed in a modular way, service or exchange of the single aluminum profiles can be done very easily. Specifically the water ceramic filter that is also installed in one of the boxes can be approached without any problem.

Cutlery and other kitchen accessories (bottle/can opener etc) can be stored in a simple plastic box that I have screwed to the bearing unit. It is accessible by a flap lid on the kitchen panel.

Well, that's already all. I might add that I carry basic dishes/cutlery for four persons with me. With that I can also invite somebody for dinner or lend one or another piece to my colleagues. Sometimes, people are very glad that I have some spare dishes with me.
